



## Inflatable Screen Setup Instructions

You will need 2 people to setup the inflatable screen.

Items: Inflatable Screen  
Blower  
4 screw stakes

### Simple Instructions: Blow up, Stand Up, Tie Down.

1. Unpack screen and lay down so white screen is facing up and "Open Air Cinema" logo to the right.
2. Undo/untangle the 2 straps attached to all 4 corners of screen and lay in a straight line away from the screen.
3. Make sure zipper on top right of screen is zipped up.
4. Attach blower to the bottom right of the screen and cinch it up using the barrel cinch on the screen.
5. Plug in blower to power and turn on. Screen will blow up in about 30 secs. **THE BLOWER MUST STAY ON.**
6. With help from another person – raise the screen and adjust orientation to how you want it. Please keep in mind that the projector and DVD player will need to be 15 to 20 feet in front of the screen depending on the screen size.
7. Screw the stakes in the ground at about 45 degree angles and about 7-12 feet away from the screen at each corner.

If you are using the screen on a hard surface or tight space – the straps can be attached or wrapped around something heavy or secure (i.e. sandbags, fence, etc.).

8. Attach the 4 top straps to each of the 4 stakes (you might have to use the cinch on the strap to let some slack out). Let out most of the slack in the top straps.
9. Attach the 4 bottom straps to each of the 4 stakes (you might have to use the cinch on the strap to let some slack out). Only necessary if windy out.
10. Tighten up all the straps.
11. Get some popcorn and enjoy the movie!!

## Screen Takedown

1. Turn off blower and unplug
2. As the screen is deflating please clamshell in half so white screen is inside
3. Detach blower from screen
4. Undo all 8 straps from the stakes. **DO NOT leave straps attached to the stakes.**
5. Unzip side vent to let air out
6. Unscrew the 4 stakes and put in supplied stake bag
7. Fold screen and stuff in blue container and put blower and stake bag on top.
